Basic Steps for Driver License, Driving Permit, and State Identification Card

- 1. Prepare <u>SSN Card</u> or get an <u>SSN Denial Letter</u>:
 - If you are an <u>F-1 or J-1 student employed on-campus</u> or <u>J-1 Scholar</u>, you can obtain a <u>Social Security Card</u> by following the steps outlined on our <u>SSN Page</u>.
 - If you are a student who doesn't have employment <u>or</u> if you are a dependent spouse or child (F-2, J-2 etc.), unfortunately, you are not eligible for a Social Security Number and will need to request a "<u>SSN Denial Letter</u>" from the Social Security Administration. The Driver's License Office requires a "<u>SSN Denial Letter</u>" if you don't have a Social Security Card <u>SSN DENIAL LETTER REQUEST</u>.
- Gather your immigration documents Make sure to take have all of your immigration documents, including your <u>I-20</u> or <u>DS-2019</u>, your valid <u>passport</u>, and a printout of your <u>I-94 Arrival/Departure Record</u>.
- 3. Make an appointment online with the Driver's License Office You will need to take both your written test and your driving test at your local driver license office. You must make an appointment online in advance.
