## **PURPOSE OF THIS FORM**

This form must be completed only once per degree program at the start of the Thesis/Dissertation Research. Once this form has been received, ISSS will continually monitor the student's enrollment for Thesis/Dissertation Research Hours until the point of degree completion.

Please note that a separate <u>Final Semester Notification (DOCUSIGN)</u> will be required in the semester in which the student will submit their final Thesis/Dissertation to the Graduate School.

## FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL GRADUATE STUDENTS

## **Full-time Enrollment Requirement**

F-1 and J-1 international students are required to maintain a full course of study each semester. Failure to maintain full-time enrollment is a violation of the F-1 or J-1 student's status. Please see our website for more details: http://international.ua.edu/isss/currentstudents/full-time-enrollment-requirement/.

Below are the general requirements to be considered full-time:

- Minimum Graduate Enrollment:
  - 9 credit hours per term some programs such as Law and MBA may require higher enrollment
  - 6 credit hours of enrollment for Graduate student with a full assistantship (.50 FTE)
- Thesis(599)/Dissertation(699) Research Hours Enrollment:
  - For Master's students in Plan 1 programs which require a thesis to graduate, during the period of Master's thesis research, the minimum required enrollment is 1 credit hour.
  - For Doctoral students' dissertation research, the minimum required enrollment is 1-3 credit hours, depending on program and whether student has met minimum dissertation research hours (See <u>Continuous Dissertation Registration for Doctoral Students</u> for details).
  - Graduate students must abide by enrollment guidelines set by The Graduate School.
- Final Semester:
  - Graduate students in their final term do not have to enroll full-time. In the final semester of study, Graduate students may enroll only in the number of hours needed to complete the degree.
  - Please refer to our <u>chart for final semester enrollment</u> and its impact on F-1/J-1 End-dates and oncampus employment eligibility.
  - Doctoral students should refer to the <u>Graduate Catalog Degree Requirements for Doctoral Students</u> Final-Semester Dissertation (699) Minimum Registration Hours and the Graduate School's website for other <u>Graduation Deadlines</u>.
  - Master's students should refer to the <u>Graduate Catalog Degree Requirements for Master's</u>
     Students and the Graduate School's website for other Graduation Deadlines.
- NOTE REGARDING ONLINE STUDY: Only one 3-credit hour online/distance learning course may count toward a student's full-time status per semester. If the student will enroll in only one course in a semester (e.g. the final semester of study), the course must be one that has some main-campus component (e.g. research hours, face-to-face meeting with professor or classroom seminars).
