# **General Admission** Requirements\*

- Overall GPA ≥ 3.0
- Statement of purpose
- Unofficial transcripts
- 3 letters of recommendation

#### Admission Test Score, if required

- GRE ≥ 300
- GMAT ≥ 500
- MAT ≥ 50th percentile
- MCAT ≥ 50th percentile

If scores for any of the above are lower than requested, you may be considered for admission with additional requirements.

\*Admission requirements vary by program. Some may not require an admission test score. Please check with your prospective program for specifics.

# **Non-Native English Speaker Requirements**

- TOEFL ≥ 79
- PTE ≥ 59
- IELTS ≥ 6.5
