





Resurgence of Travel


The Education Abroad (EA) office supported students who showed a heighted demand for study abroad as the world emerged from the pandemic.

Interesting facts from this academic year include:

- 40% of students who studied abroad in AY 21-22 had never been abroad before.
- 36 students won the prestigious US State
 Department Gilman Scholarship Award
 which provides grants up to \$5,000 for Pell
 Grant recipients to study abroad.
- 41 students participated in 2 or more study abroad programs this academic year.
- 36 faculty-led programs were launched in AY 21-22! This is an impressive number given the covid-19 travel restrictions that existed throughout this academic year.
- The UA in Belize: Tropical Conservation in Belize program was the largest faculty led program with 45 participants.
- 8 students participated in global virtual experiences, all for a full-semester, with 5 participating in full-time internship programming.




Study Abroad by Class






