The \$75 application fee and \$250 tuition deposit (\$325 total) must be paid before your application can be processed. The \$75 application fee must be paid when you submit the application.

After you have submitted your application, you will receive your CWID number and instructions to set up your myBama account by email. The University of Alabama has partnered with Flywire, which allows international students to pay securely by Visa, MasterCard, and bank transfer from any country and bank. The tuition deposit will be deducted from your tuition cost when you enroll.
