INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING TO THE INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM:

1. Complete the attached paper application form or the application form on the ELI Web site <eli.ua.edu>.
2. Send the completed application form and financial support document (see below for details) by email or fax.

Financial support document: A document showing that your sponsor has at least \$6,291 in US dollars available for each session you plan to attend. The document used most often is a letter from a bank which shows the amount of funds your sponsor has in his/her bank account. We must have a copy of your financial support letter and passport before the I-20 can be issued. We can accept these documents by fax or email.

3. If you plan to bring family members with you, please provide the following information for each of them by email or on another sheet of paper and enclose it with your application: full name/date of birth/place of birth/relationship to student. The estimated cost for each dependent is \$850 per session.

Other Costs:

- Application fee: \$75 (required – nonrefundable, valid for one year).
- Tuition deposit: \$250 (required – nonrefundable, is applied to tuition cost when a student enrolls).
- Students should plan to bring approximately \$300 - \$400 per session for personal expenses (includes bedding, towels, and personal care items).
- A \$75 Late Testing Fee is charged to new ELI students who do not take the ELI Placement Exam at the designated time (8:15 am on Day 1 of each session).
- Linen rental: \$30 (optional).

Additional Information:

- Half-sessions are available at the beginning of each full session. Starting dates for full and half sessions are the same. The estimated cost of a half-session is \$3,535 in the Fall and Spring and \$3,464 in the Summer.
- Session costs typically increase slightly each year in August, beginning with the Fall 1 session.
- The ELI’s summer sessions are designed so that students may choose to complete either one or two full-time sessions in 12 weeks. Students on an F-1 (student) visa should refer to the ELI Student Handbook for information on maintaining full-time status during the summer sessions.
