The following analysis is provided for RC019856 to assist the institution in addressing the action taken by the Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) during its meeting held on December 7, 2025:

The SACSCOC Board of Trustee reaffirmed accreditation. No additional report was requested. Your institution's next reaffirmation will occur in 2035 unless otherwise notified.

Standard 7.2 (Quality Enhancement Plan) is currently under a period of study. As such, institutions in the 2025B Class are not required to submit a one-page executive summary of the Quality Enhancement Plan, nor to submit an 'Impact Report of the Quality Enhancement Plan' as part of the 'Fifth-Year Interim Report' due five years before the next reaffirmation review.
