





Resurgence of Travel The Education Abroad (EA) office supported students who showed a heighted demand for study abroad as the world emerged from the pandemic.

Interesting facts from this academic year include:

- 567 of students who studied abroad in AY 22-23 did so for the first time.
- 51 students participated in 2 or more study abroad programs this academic year.
- 53 faculty-led programs were launched in AY 22-23! This is the most faculty-led programs run in one academic year.
- The UA in Oxford: History, English, and Honors program was the largest faculty led program with 39 participants.
- 13 students won the prestigious US State Department Gilman Scholarship Award which provides grants up \$5,000 for Pell Grant recipients to study abroad.




Study Abroad by Term


