


Education Abroad 2023 - 2024 Study Abroad Snapshot



Macroeconomics program was the largest faculty led program with 45 participants.


17 students won the prestigious US State Department Gilman Scholarship Award which provides grants up \$5,000 for Pell Grant recipients to study abroad.


